A network of forested trails lead to exposed granite ledges with stunning views of Mount Desert Island.

The southernmost trail summits Baker Hill and hosts the Downeast Phenology Trail, a volunteer citizen science project tracking the impact of climate change on plants.



Lady's Slipper Orchids emerge along the trail in spring.

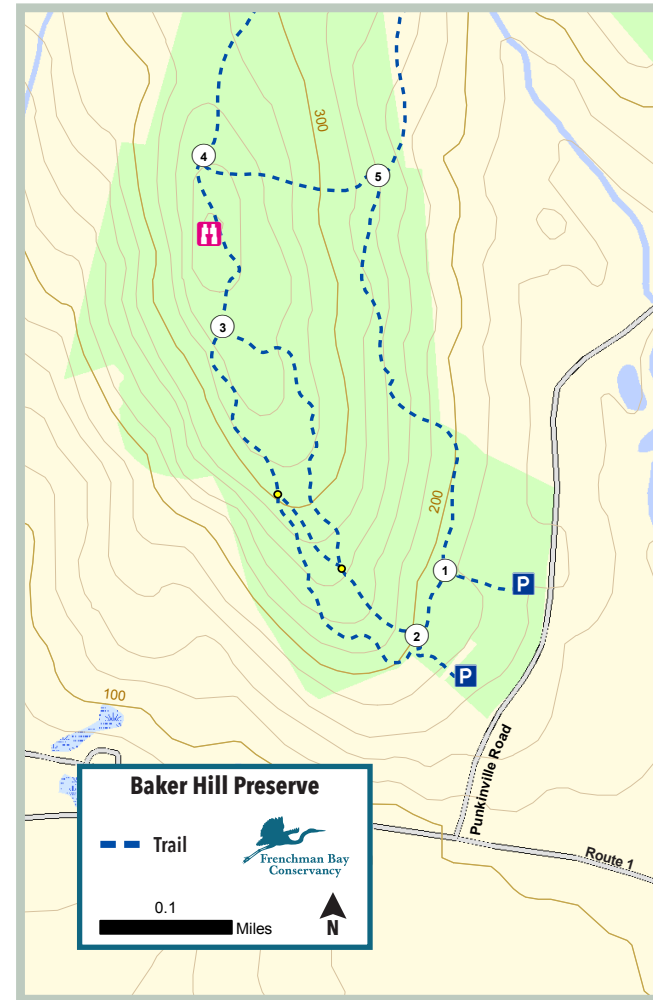


The trails at Baker Hill are popular for snowshoeing.

The trail network on this 58-acre also welcomes runners competing in FBC's annual Autumn Trail Race each November. Connects to Long Ledges Preserve and Schoodic Bog via Schoodic Connector Trail.

Directions: from Rte 1N/Hancock-Sullivan bridge, drive 3.4 miles and turn left onto Punkinville Rd (just before Sumner High School). Drive 0.2 miles to second parking lot on the left with signs for Baker Hill Preserve. *Note: Baker Hill is the second of four FBC parking lots on Punkinville Rd. Each parking lot accesses a different trailhead.*
