This simple wooded trail on a 55-acre preserve leads to Little Tunk Pond, a popular place for swimming or just lying on the beach.

In 1987, Little Tunk Preserve became one of the first properties conserved by Frenchman Bay Conservancy. The property is managed for restoration and wildlife habitat and is also protected by a conservation easement held by Maine Coast Heritage Trust. Please give loons a respectful distance.

**Directions:** from Rte 1N/Hancock-Sullivan Bridge, drive 4.4 miles and turn left on Rte 183 (Tunk Lake Rd). Continue for 4.7 miles to the parking lot on the left.
