

Forested trails wind around vernal pools, lichencovered ledges, and a small cobble quarry.

Long Pond Water District owns the pond frontage and manages this public drinking water source. Water access to swim, fish, and skate is at the permission of the water district. Please respect private property and only swim at the southern or northern ends of the pond.

In the shade of this magical upland forest, granite slabs covered in mosses and brilliant lichens glisten year-round.

Motors and ice fishing are not allowed. Trails connect to Baker Hill Preserve and Schoodic Bog Preserve via Schoodic Connector Trail.

Directions: from Rte 1N/Hancock-Sullivan bridge, drive 3.4 miles and turn left onto Punkinville Rd (just before Sumner High School). Drive 0.6 mile to the Long Ledges Preserve parking lot on the left.
