



# Salt Pond Preserve

HANCOCK #FBCSaltPond



**0.4 MILE EASY 15 MIN. ONE-WAY**

**A wooded trail on an 18-acre shore front property leads to a salt pond with views of Sullivan Harbor and Frenchman Bay.**

On the east shore of Hancock Point, a trail explores woodland, a tidal salt pond, and Carter's Beach.

To make the short trail into a longer 1.7-mile loop, walk on Carter's Beach Rd, Haskins Rd, and Point Rd. Use caution when walking along the roads.

**Directions:** from Rte 1/Hancock, take Point Rd 3.8 miles to a preserve sign and pullout on the left. Or take Eastside Rd 3.7 miles and take a left onto Point Rd to the pullout 0.1 mile on the left. To start at Carter's Beach, continue an additional 0.4 mile on Point Rd and turn left on Wharf Rd. At the end of the road, turn left, park at the Hancock Town Wharf and walk 1.3 miles to the beach.
