



The wooded Schoodic Connector Trail bridges Baker Hill and Long Ledges Preserve to Schoodic Bog Preserve and points north. The hike features beaver ponds and views of Schoodic Mountain.

The Schoodic Connector Trail links 6.5 miles of trails from Coastal Route 1 to the summit of Schoodic Mountain.

A trail on privately owned land leads to the top of Schoodic Mountain and down the other side of the mountain to the State of Maine's Donnell Pond Public Reserved Land, not shown here. (See the Schoodic Bog Preserve map for more detail.)

Directions: from Rte 1N/Hancock-Sullivan bridge, drive 3.4 miles and turn left onto Punkinville Rd (just before Sumner High School). Continue 0.1 mile to a parking lot on the left designated for hikers completing the Schoodic Connector Trail. Alternate parking is available at the Schoodic Bog Preserve.
